- **3.** The specification of the equipment supplied should be equivalent or higher than the specifications mentioned in the tender document and the bidder should specify the brand/model/make in their technical offer.
- 4. The cameras installed should cover maximum area and all corners of the Temple inside and outside.
- **5.** It is the responsibility of the bidder to handover the premises without any damages to the Trust after installation. The roof ceiling, walls, paints, glass doors etc should be maintained properly during the installation.
- 6. If any damage happen, then it is the responsibility of the bidder to repair it at their expense to the satisfaction of the Trust.
- **7.** During the installation or execution of work, the bidder should not disturb electrical lines. LAN cabling etc.
- **8.** After successful installation and testing, vendor has to impart training to the selected staff of the office to operate the equipment /NVR.
- 9. <u>The equipments supplied should be under on-site warranty for a</u> period of 3 years. After completion of the warranty, the vendor has to provide 3 years comprehensive AMC at the agreed rates. AMC Rates should be submitted along with the bid.

- **16.** Interested tenderer can visit the site and make themselves thoroughly acquainted with the local site condition, nature and requirements of the works, facilities of transport condition, effective labour and materials, access and storage for materials and removal of debris and waste materials.

17. The vendor has to take care of cost of carriage, freight and other charges as also for any difficulties, including police restrictions for transport etc. for proper execution of work as indicated in the drawings.

18. The successful vendor will not be entitled to any claim of compensation for difficulties faced or losses incurred on account of any site condition during the execution of work

19. The Temple Trust reserves the right to reject the lowest or any other tender and also to discharge any or all of the tenders for each section or to split up and distribute any item of work to any specialist firm or firms, without assigning any reason.

20. The vendor should note that the tender is strictly on the item rate basis and their attention is drawn to the fact that the rates for each and every item should be correct, workable and self-supporting.

21. The works will be paid for as "measured work" on the basis of actual work done on item rate basis and not as "lump sum" contract.

22. The Temple trust reserve the right to add /to omit any work as shown in drawings or described in specifications or include any item in schedule of quantities and intimate the same in writing but no addition, omission or variation shall be made by the contractor without authorization from the Trust. No variation shall vitiate the contract.

23. The vendor shall be deemed to have satisfied himself as to the correctness and sufficiency of his tender before making the offer for the works and of the rates and prices quoted in the

Schedule of Quantities, which rates and prices shall, except as otherwise provided, cover all his obligations under the Contract and all matters and things necessary for the proper completion and maintenance of the works.

25. The company should provide standby CCTV/NVR before taking it away from the Temple for more than 48 hours in case where the CCTV/NVR is not repairable at the location

26. Please note that the Trust will apply penalty as below in case of discrepancy in services
a) If the CCTV system is down for more than three working days, then Trust will revoke the bank guarantee
b) If the Trust observes any unsatisfactory services after sales, in discipline/ msconduct, of the authorized technicians delay in repair / maintenance, Trust will black list the company / firm.

27. The installation of the CCTV Systems and AMC of the system will be verified by technical consultant and in case the parameters as specified are not followed strictly, then amount paid by the Trust towards installation of the system in question plus Rs.25000/- as penalty will be recovered from the company and company will be black listed by the Trust. In such cases, all the expense incurred should be borne by the vendor firm itself.

28. The vendor should supply the CCTV system which can serve for a period of at least of 5 years (i.e. the life time of the CCTV should be a minimum of 5 years).

29. After warranty period, Trust is likely to engage the same vendor for AMC. During the warranty period or AMC period, if CCTV system has become beyond economical repair before the actual life period i.e. 5 years, then the vendor has replace the faulty CCTV device free of cost.

30. The supplier should give Bank Guarantee for a value of 2% on contract value

3. General Conditions:

- 1. The Successful Bidder will be engaged for supplying, installation, Testing, Commissioning, NVR, CCTV Systems to Attukal Bhagavathy Temple Trust
- **2.** The Successful Bidder will have to inform the names of their authorized technicians to be deployed at the site during the work, and their normal working hours & availability at site.
- **3.** No escalation of rate will be considered after submission of the tender.
- 4. No payment will be made towards expenses related to transportation, accommodation, food, site office, labour camps, storage etc during the execution of work.
- 5. The vendor should be able to complete the supply, installation, testing, Commissioning of 60 nos IP Cameras with NVR Systems within 30 days from the date of purchase order.
- 6. Payment Terms: Payment will be made against invoice after completion of job & submission of installation report to Trust office.
- 7. The temple trust reserves the right for the following:
 - a) Reject any or all proposals received in response to the tender without giving any reason whatsoever
 - **b)** Reject the proposals received in response to the tender containing any deviation from the payment terms stipulated
 - **c)** To independently ascertain information from other institutions at which the company / firm has already executed similar services for similar assignment.
 - d) Apply whatever evaluation criteria deemed appropriate for evaluation of Technical Bids.
 - e) To terminate the services if the assignment is not proceeding in accordance with the terms of contract or undue delay is taking place in execution of the assignment.
- 8. Decision of the Temple trust with regard to the selection of the vendor will be final and binding on the bidders.

9. Signing of Contract / agreement

The successful bidder shall sign an agreement within 7 days from date of "acceptance of the tender" With the Temple trust in the prescribed form on a judicial stamp paper. All legal expenses, incidental thereto shall be borne by the bidder. If the bidder fails to sign the agreement within the stipulated time the Trust reserves the right to reject the "Letter of acceptance" and forfeit the Earnest money deposit submitted by the bidder.

10. Permit and Licenses

Permissions from the competent authorities for transportation of the materials/equipment to execute the purchase/work orders are the responsibility of the vendor. It may be clearly understood that no compensation or additional charges can be paid by the Trust.

The software / computer programmes used to execute the purchase/work orders should be

licensed from the respective vendor/manufacturer/supplier.

The Temple trust shall be indemnified against all Temple Trust or legal actions for any mistake / illegality in the use of the materials/equipment/software used to execute the purchase/work orders.

11. Temple Trust and Local Rules

The vendor shall conform to the provisions of all local Bye-laws and Acts relating to the work and to the Regulations and directions of the Temple Trust and Local Authorities. The vendor shall give all notices required by said Act, Rules, Regulations and Bye-laws etc., and pay all fees payable to such authority/authorities for execution of the work involved. The cost, if any, shall be deemed to have been included in his quoted rates, taking into account all liabilities for licenses, fees and the vendor shall indemnify the Trust against such liabilities and shall defend all actions arising from such claims or liabilities.

12. Taxes and Duties

The vendor must include in their tender prices quoted, all duties, royalties, cess, GST or any other taxes or local charges if applicable. No extra claim on this account will in any case be entertained.

13. Quantity of work to be executed

The quantities shown in the schedule of quantities are only approximate and are intended to cover the entire premises of the temple. The Trust reserves the right to execute only a part or the whole or any excess thereof without assigning any reason thereof.

14. Earnest Money and Retention money

The bidder will have to deposit an amount Rs.10,000/- in the Tender Notice in the form of Bank Draft drawn in favour of "Secretary, Attukal Bhagavathy Temple Trust" at the time of submission of tender as Earnest Money Deposit. No interest will be paid on the Earnest money Deposit. The Earnest money of the unsuccessful bidders will be refunded without any interest soon after the decision to award the work is taken or after the expiry of the validity period of the tender.

The retention amount of 2% of the work value will be kept for 36 months from the date of completion of the work and the retention amount will be refunded to the bidder, after deducting any sum due from the bidder on any account under this contract, 30 (thirty) days after the end of defects liability period provided the bidder has satisfactorily carried out all the work and rectified all defects in accordance with the conditions of the contract. No interest will be given on retention money.

15. Bidder to arrange all necessary items.

The Bidder shall arrange everything necessary for the proper execution of the purchase/work order according to the scope of the work and technical specifications. If the bidder finds any problems/issues in executing the purchase/work order due to non-cooperation of Trust/temple employees/ or other reasons, it shall immediately brought to the

notice of the Trust. The bidder shall take full responsibility for adequacy, suitability and safety in executing the purchase/work orders during the supply, installation and implementation.

The rates quoted against individual items will be inclusive of everything necessary to complete the said items of work within the contemplation of the contract including maintaining the CCTV system during contract period, and beyond the unit price no extra payment will be allowed for incidental or contingent work, labour and/or materials or taxes and duties whatsoever except for any specific item, executed with prior consent of the Trust through separate work order.

The bidder shall supply, fix and maintain at his own cost, for the execution of any work, all tools, work and security precautions, machineries and equipments and all the necessary centering, scaffolding, staging required not only for the proper execution and protection of the said work but also for the protection of the public and safety of the Trust's property and any adjacent property and the bidder shall take down and remove any or all such centering, scaffolding etc., as occasion shall be required or when ordered so to do, and shall fully reinstate and make good all matters and things disturbed during the execution of works to the satisfaction of the Trust's office bearers / consultants.

The Trust shall on no account be responsible for the expenses incurred by the bidder/vendor during the progress of work at site, towards any incidental expenditure like medical amenities to the workers at site, security arrangement etc.

The Trust shall not be responsible for the safety of the workers at site either on account of the works executed by the bidder/vendor or on account of the works executed by any other agency involved at that time.

The Trust on no account shall be responsible for storage of materials or loss or pilferage or theft either in respect of the material stored or material already utilized at Trust premises.

Any facilities available at site shall be utilized only with prior permission of the Trust or the person in charge of the site/ building owner and cannot be taken as granted and for such services utilized the Trust is entitled to charge at its discretion.

No extra charges shall be paid over and above what has been quoted for any of the above or for similar such services.

16. Liquidated Damages

If the Bidder fails to complete the works within the time for completion stated in the tender document or elsewhere or within any extended time allowed by the Trust, the Bidder shall pay the Trust a sum at the rate of 1% (one per cent) of the Contract Value per week of delay subject to a limit of 10% (ten percent) of the Contract Value as "Liquidated damages" for the period during which the said works shall so remain incomplete and the Trust may deduct aforesaid sum towards such damages from any amount due to the Bidder.

17. Safety Measures

<u>Protective Measures:</u> The bidder from the time of commencing the works must make suitable arrangements for watching and protecting the work and no extra amount will be paid by Trust for such services.

Bidder shall indemnify the Trust against any possible damage to the building or members of the public in course of execution of the work.

Trust will not provide any protection or safety for the material kept in its premises for installation. The bidder shall take all precautions for protection of their materials during the supply and installation. The bidder/vendors shall make necessary arrangements for storage and safety of materials at site. The safety of materials at site or the stores shall be the responsibility of the bidder/vendor.

<u>Safety measures:</u> The bidder shall follow all safety measures for protecting the persons employed for the works and also for protecting the works executed and the Trust's property.

Necessary precautions in addition to the safety code annexed to these conditions shall be followed. All measuring tapes shall be of steel and suitable scaffolding and ladders that may be required for safety and taking measurement shall be supplied by the bidder.

18. Patents of appropriate authority and owners

The bidder shall conform to the provisions of any Acts of the Legislature relating to the work, and to the Regulations and Bye-laws of any authorities whose systems are proposed to use to execute the purchase/work orders. The bidder shall indemnify the Trust against all claims in respect of patent rights, royalties and damages during the execution of work and shall defend all actions arising from such claims and shall keep the Trust saved from trouble and indemnified in all respects from such actions, costs and expenses.

19. Safety Code

All suitable arrangements are to be done by the bidder and suitable scaffolds shall be provided for workmen for all works that cannot safely be done from the ground, or from solid construction, which can be done safely from ladders.

All personnel of the bidder working in the site shall be provided with safety equipments like helmets, boots etc. Adequate precautions shall be taken to prevent danger from electrical equipment and installations. No materials on any of the sites of work shall be so stacked or placed as to cause danger or inconvenience to any person or the public. Necessary safety belts shall be used while working above the ground level.
