Declaration to be furnished by the Guardian of Kuthiyottam boys, abiding the terms and conditions before the Trust Secretary at the time of Registration.

- 1) Boys registered for kuthiyottam rituals will be divided into groups of 7.
- 2) Boys who will complete 6 years of age on 23.02.2018 and not exceed 12 years as on the above date alone shall be permitted to register for the Kuthiyottam ritual.
- 3) Kuthiyottam online registration shall commence at **08.00 AM on 17th August 2017 (Thursday) and will close at 8 PM on 19/02/2018(Monday).Online Registration through the website will available up to 20/02/2018(Tuesday) 5.00PM.**
- 4) Kuthiyottam rituals, make-up of boys, escort of Diety in the divine procession, removal of “chooral” etc. shall be according to the Registration number.
- 5) Make-up materials for the Kuthiyottam boys, their dress, flowers, accompanying artists/melam for the divine procession etc. shall be provided by the temple trust. No one shall be permitted to arrange dress, artists/melam etc at their own choice.
- 6) An amount of Rs.7500/- towards the expenditure for make-up, food and dress etc for the Kuthiyottam boys and remuneration for accompanying artists should be remitted at the time of registration. On the day of starting of “Vratham”, i.e., on 24.02.2018 the guardian should bring the boy along with a cotton “thorth” and Rs.7 (as one rupee coin) for placing on the Pallipalaka as per temple rituals and handing over the boy to the temple authority. Kuthiyottam vritham starts at 8.45 AM.

- 7) From the starting of Kuthiyottam Vratham and up to “Chooral Kuthu” no food shall be given for the Kuthiyottam boys direct, from outside the temple.
- 8) On pongala day the Kuthiyottam boys after make-up, shall be grouped and with allotted accompanying art forms/melam shall be handed over to the Guardian along with country fan (Visari) and chair. The guardian should take over the boy and bring to the temple for “Chooralkuth” at their own responsibility and escort the procession to the Manacaud Shri Dharma Sastha Temple and back. After the pooja ceremonies performed at Shri Dharma Sastha Temple, the entourage returns to the Attukal temple and after prayer and removal of “Chooral” in front of temple Diety, the guardian should take over the boy from the temple.
- 9) In order to conduct the procession in an orderly manner, the selection of arts performance/melam shall be decided on the basis of draw.
- 10) No one other than the boys concerned and officials shall be permitted to enter the green room.
- 11) The dress, wig, kireedam etc of the kuthiyottam boys can be taken home, but the ‘Kindi’ issued from the temple should be returned before the make-up starts, and the chair shall be returned before the chooral is removed.
- 12) The thorth and Betel leaf required at the removal of the chooral shall be provided by the temple.
- 13) The direction issued by the Police authorities and temple authorities should be strictly followed for the smooth functioning of the procession.
- 14) If a boy is already undergoing medical treatment, the situation should be intimated to the Trust and the details of treatment should be brought in writing from the Doctor along with the medicines and handed over to the Convenor, Kuthiyottam Committee.

- 15) The declaration and the payment receipt with necessary certificates to prove the date of birth or school Identity card should be brought on the date of commencement of the Kuthiyottam, ie; on 24.02.2018
- 16) The Trust can change, add any of the above clauses, if found necessary.
